ELECTION GUIDELINES FOR THE 14TH ELECTIVE CONGRESS

1.0 FILING AND SUBMISSION OF NOMINATIONS

1. All qualified member unions under the AASU Constitution are allowed to pick and submit nomination forms within the official timelines provided in the Call for Nominations.
2. All submitted forms must be complete and truthful. Any false statement or declaration discovered at any point shall lead to disqualification, even post-election.
3. Nominations submitted after the published deadline will not be accepted under any circumstances.
4. Nominations shall be submitted via email to **14electivecongress@aasuonline.org** with all required documentation attached.

2.0 CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS

1. The 14th Elective Congress and all election-related activities shall be held entirely online.
2. Each member organisation of AASU in good financial standing shall designate one (1) delegate, who must be registered, accredited, and eligible to vote.
3. Only the designated delegate will be issued secure login credentials for voting on the virtual platform.
4. Voter identification shall be verified through pre-approved delegate lists, national ID/passport, and pre-election accreditation.
5. There shall be no voting by proxy.
6. Only official and approved information: candidate name, country, and photograph shall appear on the digital ballot.
7. Ballot positions shall be determined by the alphabetical order of the last names of the candidates.
8. Voting shall commence at 7:00 UTC and close at 17:00 UTC on election day.

3.0 COUNTING AND DECLARATION OF RESULTS

1. Positions with multiple contestants will be decided by a simple majority.
2. Candidates for unopposed positions will be confirmed by a YES/NO vote.
3. Results will be declared within **ONE HOUR** after the voting system is closed.
4. In the event that a candidate has an issue, concern, or grievance arising from the electoral process, such a matter shall be submitted in writing to the Electoral Commission (EC). The EC shall acknowledge receipt of the complaint and ensure that appropriate redress is provided within **twenty-four (24)** hours of submission.



4.0 MISCELLANEOUS
